The requirements for this challenge are listed below for 1st through 4th grade students for the 2017-18 school year. You have the option to read picture books or chapter books. Students leaving kindergarten can read their SFA Shared Stories. Students leaving 1st-3rd grade should read books at his/her reading level. The forms for book completion are attached to this letter. Please return completed forms to your 2017-2018 homeroom teacher by **Friday, September 1st**. Students who complete the reading challenge will get to participate in a field trip.

Requirements:

Students must read 15 books!

1-60 pages (count as 1 book)

61-120 pages (count as 2 books)

121 pages or more (count as three books)

Students must write a couple sentences about each book.

We hope you continue to read over the summer. Reading for enjoyment is a wonderful pastime. It lets you go to many new places, meet several new characters, and go on any adventure you choose. So pick up a book and get started with your Summer Reading Challenge.
