March 20, 2017

The Hancock County Board of Education met in special session on Monday, March 20, 2017, in the Board Room, New Cumberland, commencing at 5:00 p.m. Board Members present: Michelle Chappell, John Manypenny, Caroll Rosenlieb, Tim Reinard, and Toni Hinerman, President.

The purpose of this meeting: Public hearing to provide input in the development of the 2017-2018 Hancock County School Calendar.

Miss Petrovich explained the school calendar, calendar rules and announced that there will be a survey that gives students, parents, teachers and other employees a chance to weigh in on the school calendar. The survey will be on the counties website from March 22nd through April 5th.

People in attendance were given time to voice their concerns and/or opinion regarding the calendar. There were concerns voiced asking the Board to consider a preparation day or something comparable between semester for the high school teachers. Another concern was making the survey more accessible to students, possibly printing the survey off for the students to complete, it was decided to leave the survey online, and to use school messenger to call students and staff to make them aware of the survey.

The next public hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, April 18, 2017 in the Board Room, New Cumberland, starting at 5:00 p.m.

Mrs. Hinerman stated that she would like the board to meet in executive session for a personnel issue.
